

HEALTH FACTS

GOOD DAY SUNSHINE

Vitamin D is known as the "sunshine" vitamin. The body produces Vitamin D when the skin is exposed to sunlight. Vit. D helps absorb calcium, which is needed for bone strength. Vitamin D is also found in food such as fish, eggs, mushrooms, and fortified foods such as milk.

Vitamin D deficiency can cause rickets, a disease in which the bone tissue is soft and causes deformities. Blood tests can measure Vit. D levels

Most experts recommend sun exposure to one third of our skin for 10-30 minutes, three times per week. Also available are daily supplements. The recommendations are: Vit. D 600 IU for adults under 70 years of age; Vit. D 800 IU for older adults; children's doses should be recommended by a pediatrician. Your daily multivitamin will also contain a level of Vitamin D.

Remember what John Lennon and Paul McCartney said, "We take a walk, the sun is shining down. Good day sunshine".
